The Angelina College Financial Aid Office assists students with financial aid questions. Financial Aid Counselors are ready to answer questions about grant programs and scholarships. Our phone number is (936) 633-5291 and website is www.angelina.edu.

Angelina College's Financial Aid Office is located on the second floor of the Student Center, room 208.

Financial Aid Counselors assist students in completing their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) application. This application determines a student's eligibility for financial aid. (Federal or state grants). These grants include:

- Federal Pell Grant
- Texas Public Education Grant (TPEG)
- Academic Competitiveness Grant
- Federal/Texas Workstudy Program

Through the Federal/Texas Workstudy Program, AC assists students interested in working on- or off-campus. Off-campus opportunities include working in a Reading or Math Literacy program at area elementary schools or the Adult Learning Center.

Students interested in scholarships are encouraged to apply early. The Fall deadline is in March of each year and the Spring deadline is in November. Scholarships range from \$100 per semester to \$600 per semester. Information and applications are available on AC's website, www.angelina.edu, "General Information", "Financial Aid". A single application covers any scholarship listed in the General Bulletin or on the scholarship webpage stating "Apply to the Angelina College Scholarship Committee". Other scholarship donors have their names and addresses listed for students to obtain applications from their organizations. If applicable, SAT and/or ACT scores should be included on the application, as well as major or chosen field of study. Some scholarships are "major specific" and require that the student list their chosen field of study.

IMPORTANT DATES: Although scholarship applications may be submitted at anytime during the term, priority is given to students whose applications are received by the deadlines listed below:

For graduating high school students:

February 1 – first round awards
March 1 - second round awards
June 15 - third round awards

For Current Angelina College students:

June 15 - fall semester awards
November 15 - spring semester awards

A complete application MUST include the following:

1. The completed Academic Scholarship Application form.
2. Current transcript of high school or college work. High School transcripts should include class rank and number of students in class.
(A separate copy from any currently on file in Admissions or Records Office.)
3. Written verification of ACT/SAT test scores.
4. A one-page letter written by the applicant explaining his or her educational goals.

NOTE: Applications for the Angelina Challenge scholarship must include a copy of the student's federal Student Aid Report (SAR).

Your application will NOT be considered unless it contains ALL items listed in 1-4 above.

Applicant's Certification: To the best of my knowledge the information reported above is complete and correct. I understand that certain scholarships require that I successfully complete at least twelve (12) semester hours each semester and maintain a minimum grade point average of 3.00 in order to be eligible to continue receiving that scholarship. The award letter will indicate the specific requirements of the scholarship.

SCHOLARSHIP CATAGORIES

▶ GENERAL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are available primarily to recent high school graduates who have demonstrated academic excellence in high school. However, some academic scholarships are awarded to continuing students at AC or transfer students who have demonstrated academic excellence in their college courses. To be considered for an academic scholarship, the student is strongly encouraged to submit ACT or SAT test scores with the scholarship application. Applications that include ACT or SAT scores will be given preference.

▶ ANGELINA CHALLENGE AWARD

This scholarship is reserved for recent graduates of accredited public high schools in Angelina County and is awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. To be eligible for this award, students **must apply for the Pell Grant** and must not qualify for more than \$800 in financial aid. (i.e. Pell, other federal and state grants, Angelina College scholarships, third party scholarships and other aid).

▶ BOON SCHOLARSHIPS

There are two Boon Scholarships, the Boon Opportunity Scholarship and the Boon Teaching Award. The Boon Opportunity Scholarship is reserved for adult students returning to college from the world of work or homemaking, or students completing their GED. The Boon Teaching Award is reserved for students in a pre-education major from one of the counties in the college service area who plan to teach in this area upon completion of their degree.

▶ HEALTH CAREERS SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are reserved for students currently enrolled in a health careers program.

▶ VIVIAN EZELLE JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are reserved for students who have a documented physical or learning disability.

▶ SHANDS FAMILY SCHOLARSHIPS

These scholarships are reserved for students who have financial need that is not met by other scholarships or financial aid. Priority is given to students majoring in high demand occupations.
