



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT AGREEMENT

International students who are applying to attend Angelina College with an F-1 visa must abide by the Angelina College policies and the U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) rules. It is the student’s responsibility to know and obey these regulations or face possible removal from the United States. These regulations can be found online at www.uscis.gov.

International students wishing to attend Angelina College must read each sentence below carefully and initial indicating that they agree to abide by these conditions.

Student initials

Upon entering the U.S. for the first time, the student must report to the International Student Advisor / DSO within seven (7) days of the program start date indicated on the I-20.	
The international student must be present for the first day of class each semester, Only under extenuating circumstances (death in family, surgery, visa / passport issues), may the student arrive after the first day and must have approval from the DSO and their professors.	
The international student must submit their travel / arrival dates before each semester to the DSO for approval. The student must arrive on campus no more than one week prior to the first day of school each semester.	
A student must maintain full-time enrollment status each Fall and Spring semester of enrollment. For the Fall and Spring terms, full-time status is considered 12 semester hours or more. During the summer terms, 6 hours is considered full-time.	
The student is limited to only one online class per semester.	
Should an emergency occur and the student wishes to drop below full time, they must notify the DSO before they drop.	

An F-1 Visa holder is limited to part-time employment on campus. They must apply through the Human Resources Department.	
All international students give permission to their DSO to use their personal information to search for and print their current I-94 while enrolled at Angelina College.	
If a student requests to extend their expiration date on the I-20, they must report to the DSO thirty (30) days prior to the program end date on the I-20.	
A student who graduates must depart the United States within sixty (60) days of completing their course of study.	
If a student intends to transfer to another college or university, the student must inform the DSO in writing thirty (30) days prior to the transfer date and before the completion of the course of study at Angelina College. They must also provide an acceptance letter from the school to which they are transferring.	
It is the international student's responsibility to ensure that full payment of financial debts incurred by their enrollment at Angelina College is paid in full by the end of each semester of enrollment. Payments must be made according to your payment plan by the deadline to avoid being dropped from classes. Any outstanding balance will prevent the student from registering for the upcoming semester or transferring their I-20 out to another U.S. Institution.	
A student must keep their passport valid at all times and carry their passport, I-94, and I-20 with them at all times.	
If a student travels outside the U.S. and they plan to re-enter, they must have their I-20 (travel endorsement) signed by the DSO before leaving the U.S.	



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
